

## Enduro Engineering Aluminum Exhaust Guard Installation



- 1** Remove the stock plastic frame/exhaust guard. (See Fig.1)
- 1a** You will need to use a 3mm Allen to loosen the bolt, then pull the frame guard straight out from this position. (see Fig. 2)
- 2** Once the plastic guard is removed proceed to trace and cut away the existing “exhaust shield” portion of the plastic guard. (See Fig. 3)
- 3** Using an 8mm T-handle or socket remove the lower side panel bolt. (See Fig.4)
- 4** Using a T45 Torx T-handle or socket remove the lower sub-frame bolt. (See Fig.5)
- 5** Position your new Aluminum EE exhaust guard with the top mounting hole located between the side panel and the sub-frame; use the provided 6x25mm hex head bolt to fasten at this location. Note: only finger tight at this time. (See Fig.6)
- 6** Apply some thread locking agent to the provided 8x25mm flat head bolt, and using a T45 Torx T-handle or socket fasten the exhaust shield to the lower sub-frame mount. (See Figures 7, 7.1)
- 6a** Once both bolts have been started, proceed to tighten them until the exhaust shield is secure.
- 7** Re-install the “modified” plastic frame guard using the two provided zip ties in the appropriate locations, then tighten the 4mm Allen bolt at the swing arm pivot point.
